Mefo Mousse

Variants

- 0 mousse with 0 marking is usually put into /100-19 (100- 110-18) (125ccm) tyres, we have tested on Dunlop, Pirelli, Mitas tyres
- 1 mousse with the marking 1 is ideal for /110-19 (120-18/130-140-18 FIM ENDURO) tyres, again we have tested on Dunlop, Pirelli, Mitas tyres
- 2 the mousse with the marking 2 is suitable for tires /120-19 (130 -140-18), however, many racers also put this mousse on tires/110-19, the life is a little longer, but it does not have as good grip as the variant 1, the assembly itself will also be a little more difficult

Description:

GROOVE - Mousse with a groove, the groove serves to better lubricate the gel, which stays there for a long time

EX - extreme enduro - softer, so to meet the demanding conditions, the tire must be under-inflated to allow the rider to climb well over rocks and slippery roots.

OVAL - oval profile for a low profile tire, many riders use this type of mousse as the rubber adheres very well to the trail surface

DESERT - protrusions for better grip

HARD - hard

MEDIUM - soft

TUBE - with inner tube, one of the ideal options for enduro and CC, the rider can inflate the tyre to meet his requirements, even a very under-inflated tyre with mousse protection can be an ideal option for demanding rides
